SEVENTY-FIVE BOYS ARE AT CAMP DAVIS

Camp Davis, located at Gascon, 31 miles northwest of Las Vegas, is now in full swing with an enrollment of 75 boys from Texas, Kansas, Oklahoma and Louisiana. The boys range in age from nine to 17 years of age.

Mr. and Mrs. J. Davis of Lubbock, Texas, operate the camp. Prior to leasing the Gascon site three years ago, they operated a boys camp at El Pervenir for eight years. Assisting them are 11 counselors and their families.

The present encampment opened June 8 and will continue until July 6. From July 6 until August 3, 75 girls will occupy the camp.

Camping activities are highlighted by pack trips horseback into the mountains, according to Mrs. Davis. Other recreation offered includes horseback riding, fishing, swimming, tennis, archery, badminton, and table games.
